What the Auction Supports

SAHG's 16th Annual Auction will raise over one-third of the money needed to support operations in 2008. King County, the most populous county in Washington State (781,976 households), has an overwhelming need for affordable housing. This need is particularly acute on the Eastside. Between 1990 and 2000, households living in overcrowded conditions with more than two persons per room rose 50% statewide and by over 200% on the Eastside (US Census Bureau).

St. Andrew's Housing Group description & background

mission statement

St. Andrew's Housing Group (SAHG) is dedicated to improving the quality of life for people with limited income on King County's Eastside, empowering these families to succeed by providing housing and access to services while strengthening local communities and encouraging diversity.

a glimpse at "us"

Today, SAHG provides 325 units of affordable housing on King County's Eastside, serving more than 800 individuals and families each year. SAHG provides affordable housing in the following Eastside communities: Mercer Island, Issaquah, Factoria, Redmond, Bellevue and Kirkland.

SAHG is operated by nine qualified, professional staff and governed by an engaged and effective 18-member Board of Directors. The Board includes members from the Eastside and Seattle who bring experience in commercial, industrial and mixed-use housing construction and management, commercial and nonprofit real estate development, community development finance and real estate law. Each Board member financially contributes each year, actively participates in fundraising and serves on at least one committee.

St. Andrew's Housing Group serves the poor, including those transitioning directly from homelessness as well as the working poor. Currently, 38% of SAHG's residents are children, 46% are female-headed households and 10% of the households were formerly homeless.

our approach

SAHG is a recognized leader among its housing development peers, working collaboratively to create more affordable housing and provide necessary support services. Currently SAHG has partnerships with Hopelink and the YWCA to provide supported service units for 22 formerly homeless families. Most recently, SAHG has been working with St. Margaret's Episcopal Church in Factoria developing plans for a brand new 40-unit property; with 26 units reserved for veterans transitioning out of homelessness and 20 of the total units set-up as supportive housing. Andrew's Glen construction is set to launch summer 2010.

This past summer, SAHG launched a successful pilot Residents Services program at Highland Gardens in Issaquah and has applied for and received the funding necessary to begin implementing these kinds of programs at all of their 10 properties.

Additionally, SAHG works closely with A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH), The Housing Development Consortium (HDC), and the Washington Low-Income Housing Alliance to support the passing of state legislation that preserves and promotes affordable housing and its development.
